

Record entries in North Derby

B. Baulderstone won the SAHPA young bird North Derby on Saturday, August 5, from a record nomination of 6,151 birds representing 363 owners.

Released at Tarcoola at 8 a.m., the bird was clocked just before 1.10 p.m., flying the 606km. at a velocity of 32.686 m.p.s. (metres per second).

Returns on the day were very good, with little separating the first 30 place-getters.
