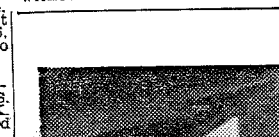

In any case, the Grooter in anything like its original purity does not exist in Australia to the best of my knowledge.

There are breeders of this blood overseas, but our import restrictions are such that it is not possible to import pigeons into Australia.

These restrictions have been in force for so many years that it is not likely any birds of Grooter blood have been introduced here for the past 20 years.
