

# Hard Maryborough Race

The association's Maryborough race last Saturday proved another tough event which was won by Lefevre partners Lloyd and Sawford.

In contrast with the three Marree races, all easy and failing to provide a measuring stick to assess the quality of young birds, the three Maryboroughs were all hard races which left no doubt about the value of the early arrivals.

While it is certain that they have taken their toll of a percentage of good birds, it is also true that the duds not worth feeding have been weeded out.

Released at 7.15 a.m. leading birds, reached the shorter distance lofts at about 4.4 p.m.

Lloyd and Sawford's winner was clocked at Semaphore at about 5.13 p.m. to defeat F. Fraser's second prizewinner timed at about 5.7 p.m. Returns in the day did not amount to 49 p.c.

Liberated into a stiff head-wind at Onadadatta, about 200 of 1,022 birds representing the Union and Combine returned to the release point half an hour later. Subsequently a patchy race resulted with the Union's winner clocked by E. and N. Hawkes (Oaklands) at about 9.30 a.m. Sunday.

Arrivals were few and far between. The third prize-winner was timed at about 10.50 a.m. — and it was reported that not many over 100 of the 548 were home by Sunday night.

One owner with more than 50 entries had a return of about 6 p.c. The winner of the Combine's event for M. Hatherly (Stirling) reached Adelaide (at about line) 11.12 p.m. L. Thamm (Riverside) with two arrivals together finished second and third.
