HOUBENS HOUBENS HOUBENS

Houben is now a household word in Australian racing pigeon circles. Jef, Luc and Nadia with the other members of their family have developed a strain of birds capable of achieving remarkable results.

In 1998, seven pairs were imported from Martyn Mitchell of Woodlands Farm Stud. Many fed winners have been bred from these pairs as well as a large number of placegetters. It is an impossible task to list them all. You probably know others that I don't know. Alan Marcon had two pairs, Peter Ware four pairs (References 1 to 8) and another fancier one pair. In March 2001 I bought the four imported pairs from Peter Ware with some of their young ones. Later I bought a hen from Alan Marcon bred off his champion pair. She is Reference 10.Her father has bred three VHA Fed winners, two for A & D Marcon and the Mildura winner for Michael Lucas. He is even in the pedigree of one of Michael's 600 mile fed winners. Her mother has bred two VHA Fed winners. Reference 10 has bred me many fed places. See notes at end of catalogue. Last year I bought the other imported hen from Alan. She is Reference 11. She is the dam of Michael Lucas' Mildura fed winner. Details of each of the reference birds are listed with their pedigrees at the back of the catalogue.

Over the past four years I have won a total of 34 Young Bird, Old Bird and Ten Bird positions. Most are bred off these HOUBENS. Some are pure, many are the results of crosses. Last year I won seven of the twenty races in the Old Bird Series in my local club, Waverley. As many of you know, I can't spend much time near the birds due to health problems, but I certainly enjoy my birds and the sport in general.

Two years ago, Elizabeth and I visited the Houben Family in Belgium. This proved to be a fascinating insight into how the birds are bred, raced, fed, motivated and managed. Luc and I discussed the pedigrees of my reference birds, at length. He was surprised that birds of such breeding had arrived in Australia. As a result of the visit, I ordered, and now have, another batch of new imports. The plan is to mate them to my originals as suggested by Luc. A few of these late- bred babies are included in the sale. I cannot write down all of the details of the new birds, but their ring numbers and their parents are listed in the catalogue. I would, therefore, suggest you contact the Houben web-site to explore all of the information relevant to these newly imported young pigeons.

You will notice that the new ones are closely bred to Jonge Arteist, Cindy (the National Winner) and Sun City winners. One of the new imports is a grand daughter of Mr Sun City and Miss Sun City. They won 350,000 U.S. dollars in South Africa at Sun City. This young hen is a significant addition to the gene pool of Australian racing pigeons. On the day of the sale the original pedigrees will be available for you to peruse. Another young

one is a grandson of Rico, the grandsire of the 2003 Sun City winner! Check out Colour of Water, bred by Carlos Avilla, of the U.S.,on the Sun City web-site. She is also a grand daughter of Mr Sun City and Miss Sun City.

While in Belgium we spent some time with Martyn Mitchell, the breeder of the eight original imports. We discussed the pedigrees of the birds, their performances and what their brothers and sisters had achieved in England. It was no surprise to learn that they were sought after in England too. Some flown by Barrie Fidler, bred down from these same birds from Martyn Mitchell, have enabled him to become a well-known British champion.

As I mentioned above it is impossible to list the performances, so your own research would be beneficial. The Sun City web-site is: www.scmdpr.com

The Sun City Race is a great challenge for Australian fanciers. Birds from all over the world, bred by the world's best fanciers compete. Stephen Kearsey has enjoyed successes with birds bred off my original imports. In 2003, Harry Houdini, won \$3,000 Australian dollars. He was bred off Reference 3 and 4. Young ones off Reference 7 and 8 have achieved pleasing results. His 15th Fed 500 miles, last year, is a grand daughter of four of the originals. David Finerty's 500 mile fed hen, 2005, has the same birds in her pedigree.

Most of us are aware of the outstanding results of the late John Wetering. For example, refer to the Young Bird Series 2004. The week before the first fed John had the fastest VHA velocity. Its dam was bred off Reference 7 and 8. The next week John won the fed from Korong Vale. Its dam was also off Reference 7 and 8. Next week, John won 4th Fed. Its sire was off Reference 1 and 2. John won 3rd Fed from Wycheproof, the same bird that won the fed from Korong Vale. Next week, he won 2nd Fed, from a son of Reference 1 and 2. John won 4th Fed again the next week. This one was bred off a son of Reference 5 mated to his daughter bred off reference 5 and 6. John won the Young Bird Aggregate. Later in old birds these birds bred another winner too.

Last year, Mick Dobric won the Greater Melbourne, Dandenong Club Aggregate. This was helped largely by a fed win off a brother of Reference 10 and another fed win off a sister of Reference 10.

As I mentioned before it is impossible to list all of the performances of these birds. Sufficient to say that they have this amazing strike rate for the small number of imported birds. The reason is that they are so versatile, they win from the first young bird club race to the last old bird race. They stop! Somehow, they know when to break and not to over fly. Short flyers really value this trait. They are great performers at club, section & fed over land and water. It doesn't even matter if the race is fast or steady.

Most of the birds offered for sale are young ones. Two years ago I sold thirty young ones. Last year I selected many of the direct young ones from the original imports for stock. The young ones in this sale are their first youngsters. Because they are young ones bred off yearlings they are strong and vigorous. They have not had any medication, they haven't ever needed any. They have been bred for stock. Unfortunately, I can't guarantee the sex of these birds. It would be your responsibility to make an informed decision. Good luck.
