

DE SENNA COMES TO OAK HAVEN

On Jan. 21, 1993 the official National Ace Pigeon Award Winners for Holland for 1992 were announced. De Senna quickly drew the attention of agents from Holland, Belgium, and Taiwan and for 5 days a fierce bidding battle took place. When the battle ended it was announced De Senna was bought by Oak Haven Farms for a record price of \$33,000 U.S. De Senna is Van Loon bred by Leo Vieveen. At our Connecticut auction in 1996 the two highest priced birds sold for \$6,000 and \$3,525, both were sons of SENNA!
