Every now and again there comes an opportunity for fanciers to obtain first class racing pigeons, and in my opinion this sale represents one of those rare opportunities.

Colin Hawke does not normally sell pigeons but he new finds that he has more birds than he requires and has decided to part with these birds, and has arranged for this sale here in Melbourne. He has had a lot of enquiries since the great performances of Terry Groves of Diamond Valley in the past few years with the Hawke birds.

In Adelaide the Hawke pigeons have been very successful over a long number of years, both Colin and his brother Don have won a number of lat's in South Australia Pigeon Association Federation races with this family of birds.

Generally we have found here in Melbourne that a lot of the pigeons from other States have not been all that successful here, but the Hawke pigeons have done well for the few that have had them. The family of birds have been very successful in races in South Australia particuarly in the races from 375 miles to 500 miles, when the birds are home on the day. This is probably one of the reasons why they have done well here as they are real racers and not the slow plodding type of bird.

Very few of these birds have been sent here but of the few that have I know that Norman Rees raced with great success with these pigeons, and Jack Harrison and myself have had good winners from a couple of birds that Colin sent to both of us. But the greatest advert for the Hawke pigeons is the tremendous success that Terry Groves of Diamond Valley Club has had inthe VHA in the past two years. Terry who joined in 1976 has certainly show his capability as a pigeon funcior, in the VHA he has been 5th Old Bird Average, 5th Combined Average in 1976, in 1977 he was 5th Young Bird Averagre, 10th Old Bird Average, 3rd Combined Averages, 12 VHA Federation places in the two years, including 2nd Mildura, 4th Renmark, 2nd Morgan 1976, and 1st Wycheproof Y.B.Derby, 1st Mildura 1977 a series of wins that anyone would be proud of. Terry informs me that all of these major winners were bred off the four pairs of pigeons that he got from Colin Hawke, being either directly off the Hawke pigeons or half bred off them, so I do not think that there could be any better recommendation than the performances of Terry Groves that these Hawke pigeons can win here in Victoria.

Colin Hawke will be here on the day of the Sale of his birds and he can advise anyone interested on any of the birds that he is offering for sale.

POREWARD

Having been in the sport of Pigeon Racing the last forty years I have enjoyed much success here in Adelaide, and I find now I am overstocked and must cut down my numbers, so I am offering, for the first time, a lovely lot of birds for Auction. I have won 8 Federation Races, and have had many placings over all

distances, which are far too numerous to mention.

I hold the record of winning 9 races in my Club, in one season, twice. I have won the Club Aggregate many times. Also runner up 3 times in the Association points.

The birds are a wonderful family that I have kept for the last 30 yrs, their bloodlines are:

> JANSSEN BRICOUX SION STASSART

Two pairs of JANSSENS were imported out from England by the late Jim Simpson and the late Charlie Henderson, from whom I procured a cock bird (Smokey Blue Cheq.Cock). The SION was imported to South Aust. by the late Harold Taylor, and I was able to procure a pair of SIONS (S.A.A 45 10685 Blue.B.Cock & Y.B.C 46 621 Blue.C.Hen) down from the imported birds. Harold Taylor also imported the BRICOUX out , of which I was able to secure a pair, (S.A.A.43 133 Blue C.W/F Cock & S.A.A 43 Blue.C.P. Hen). I mated the JANSSEN & BRICOUX together, and then added the SION with them, and they started winning races the first year I flew them.

A couple of seasons later I went to the late Charlie Henderson, well known to all fanciers, and bought a beautiful " BLUE GOWN MONA" Stassart Cock, which I used as a cross, he also left his mark. So you can see these birds have the best blood lines, and this is the family I am offering.

The two birds that are the force behind my birds are a RED CHEQUER COCK S.A.D 61 14131, a real champion, and a BLUE CHEQUER PIED HEN S.A. 64 5606, also a champion on the track & producer.

THE RED CHEQUER COCK 14131 WAS SIRED BY A SON OF THE ORIGINAL SMOKEY BLUE CHEQ. JANSSEN COCK. THE DAM WAS A RED CHEQ HEN Y.B.C.57 2224 (STILL LIVING). SHE WON THE YOUNG BIRD DERBY- ASSOCIATION FROM MARREE 370 MILES, 10% HOURS ON THE WING IN 1958. (HER EROTHER WAS 2nd IN THE YOUNG BIRD DERBY ASSOCIATION IN 1957 - 9% HOURS).

THE BLUE CHEC PIED HEN WAS SIRED BY THE SAME SON OF THE ORIGINAL SMOKEY BLUE CHEQ JANSSEN COCK. THE DAM WAS A RED CHEO HEN- STASSART SION (SHE WAS 10th Assoc. OCDNADATTA 550 MILES)

THE TWO CHAMFION BIRDS : % BROTHER & SISTER.

The Red Cock 14131 flew for five seasons and won 9 races and numerous placings. He won a lot of money in pools (CLUB MEMBERS NAMED HIM MONEY BAGS").

The Blue.C.Pied Hen 5606 did not race as a yearling, but as a two year old. She was 1st PIMBA 270 Miles, 5th Association MARREE 370 Miles, 4th Association MARREE 370 Miles, 5th Codnadatta 550 Miles,

in the one season.
Both have produced me some wonderful pigeons. So you can see these birds have excellent performances behind them. These birds will win on fast or slow velocities, and are at their very best on an all day fly.

Fanciers who have had success with my birds, and only a few have left my loft, are as follows:

The late Fred Williams, BOX HILL, Norman Rees, V.H.A Neil Young, V.P.U. Barry & Ray Hunt PERTH.W.A. (who have enjoyed much success) and most recently Terry Groves, V.H.A, who has had two excellent seasons in the V.H.A.

My brothers Don & Ken Hawke were both top flyers in their Clubs, with the birds I gave them.
In conclusion I would say that anyone looking for a good outcross to improve his birds, could not do any better than this family.
And I am sure the purchasers of these pigeons will be well repaid by their performances.

P.S - Recently my brother and I procured several birds from Hector Petagna, now deceased, who imported the MOSS and PUTEMANS, and was a top flier in PORT PIRIE, South Aust. I included a pair of these birds when I sent the other birds to Terry Groves, and last season he finished 2nd MARREE 700 miles, with a lovely hen off this pair.
