RACING IN THE "SILVER CITY"

Well if you have thought racing the south east line has been tough last year then spare a thought for your country cousins. The move for me to Broken Hill hasn't been easy, but in the sport of pigeon racing it has been a lot tougher. I was told before the start of the season "you won't find racing here as easy as in the city, you haven't got the 1000's of birds to bring them home". They were right; the birds up here are "bloody tough" and have been bred in these harsh conditions to home on their own. If you have purchased any of these birds in the Sires Produce just remember, there're not just scrubbers from the bush.

The Barrier & Broken Hill Club in 2013 had 11 flyers; they have been extremely helpful but fiercely competitive. This year we have two new members re entering the sport, Bill & Georgina Drewery, from Leeton NSW, and George Muscat, who, after a break of around 10 years is back for another crack at the sport. Here in the "Hill" the club runs its own truck, a Mercedes Sprinter tray top converted to take 8 full width bays and can carry enough feed and water for a week.

Racing is on one line only (west line last year and east line this year) and starts off at 105 kilometers and will end up at Penong on the west line and Gilgandra on the east line a distance of 800 kilometers. Most weeks we have two races and around 120 birds are sent to each race.

Flying up here is all prepaid in race packs such as a 5, 10, 12, 14 or "whatever number you want to fly" lot of birds. This means you can fly your pack every race without extra cost, but should you decide to send more then it may cost you a dollar each bird over the prepaid pack you have purchased. Fees can be paid in installments, and prize money is shown up front for each race. The prize money is paid out for 1st 2nd and 3rd positions, but not paid out until the end of the season; it is all made simple and flyer friendly.

Most flyers would have heard of the "Silver City or Broken Hill \$10,000 Classic" this has been the clubs main fundraiser. This event was put on hold due to a lack of finding a suitable "spare" loft at which to hold it, but I'm sure this will return in the near future. Meanwhile the club is very thankful of the many community minded sponsors who help the club out during the year with generous donations some of those being the Broken Hill Community Credit Union, Silver City Wreckers and Top End Meat who always give us enough meat for several BBQ's.

The weekend of the 17th of August 2013 saw us flying the Minlaton Young Bird Derby 475 kms, with a Bute race stop on the way back. Spare another thought for those up here without electronic timing, if you can't find someone to clock in for you, and you can't beat the birds back its tough luck. I was lucky enough to have 2 birds land and win the Derby with equal velocity thanks to the Tipes system. This year 2014 will see four of us with Tipes electronic timing. Every care is taken with the birds to ensure maximum returns. A tail wind can often see the birds pushed way past the town and a north wind will send the birds way south of the town. The returns are generally quite good on the races, thanks to the care taken by the members who convoy the birds.

There is always quite a healthy rivalry for the points, and last years points winners were 1st Brian Ashwood, 2nd Wayne Pollard, 3rd Brian Drury (pub officer), 4th Craig Loft (Steve Craig, Chairperson) 5th Peter Burke, 6^{th and} Breeder's Plate winner Ken Malloch, 7th Rob Graham, 8th Alan Roberg, 9th Secretary Jeff King, 10th Marie Ferguson, and 11th was Trevor Gillett who only flew several races with a small team.
